

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

## For AJ

- Wooden crafting egg\*
- AJ printable templates
- Scissors
- · Craft glue
- · White, black, and red modeling clay

#### For Blaze

- · Dozen-egg carton, cut lengthwise
- · Red and white paint
- Crafting glue
- · Blaze templates
- Scissors

## Optional

· Cardstock paper (for wheels)



# \*Parent Tip

Using wooden or plastic eggs is a sure-fire way to avoid the breakies and the smellies. You know what we mean...

## **HOW TO MAKE**

## STEP 1 - MAKE AJ

Print and cut the templates. Glue the face and mouth pieces to the egg, using the photo for reference.

## STEP 2

Using the white clay, shape three flat circles, and apply one each to the sides and top of AJ's head to make his helmet. place a U-shaped stripe of black clay around the edge of the top of the helmet. Place a smaller piece of red clay inside that, leaving a white ring in between the red and black. Affix the flame templates on both sides of the helmet. Use the photo for reference. Set aside to dry.

# STEP 3 - MAKE BLAZE

Cut the top half of the egg carton in half, widthwise. Paint one half white and discard the other half. Allow to dry.

#### STEP 4

Cut the bottom, cup-side half of the egg carton in half, widthwise. Paint one half red and discard the other half. Allow to dry.

# STEP 5

Once cartons are dry, nestle the red, cup side onto the white, bottom side. Print and cut the Blaze face, flames, and wheels and glue onto the "body" of the car, using the image for reference. Once you've glued, remember to paint over the front tab of Blaze's face with red paint.

# STEP 6

Place AJ into the driver's seat and let's blaaaze!
