

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Wooden crafting egg\*
- · Shine printable templates
- Scissors
- · Craft glue
- · Brown sharpie
- · Aquamarine paper rectangle, 1.5x6 inches
- · Dark blue modeling clay

#### \*Parent Tip

Using wooden or plastic eggs is a sure-fire way to avoid the breakies and the smellies. You know what we mean...

# **HOW TO MAKE**

#### STEP 1

Print and cut the templates. Glue the eyes, eyebrows, and mouth pieces to the egg, using the photo for reference. Use the brown sharpie to draw on Shine's nose, using the photo for reference.

### STEP 2

While the face dries, curl the aquamarine rectangle into a ring and staple or glue it closed. Cut and glue the torso template to the paper ring without affixing the arms (use photo for reference). \*Optional: Glue rhinestone onto the ring to add extra shine to Shine!

## STEP 3

Once face has dried (~½ hour), shape Shine's hair base out of the modeling clay, using the photo for reference.

#### STEP 4

Attach the ponytail template to the crown of her head, using the photo for reference. Then glue on Shine's headpiece, ears, and earrings, leaving the tips of the ears and the earrings unglued. Add rhinestones as desired. Rest your Shine egg on her genie stand!
