

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Hot pink plastic egg*
- Yellow modeling clay
- 2 red pipecleaners, 4 inches each
- Milli printable templates
- Scissors
- Craft glue
- Pink construction paper rectangle, 1.5x7 inches
- Staple (optional)

***Parent Tip**

Using wooden or plastic eggs is a sure-fire way to avoid the breakies and the smellies. You know what we mean...



HOW TO MAKE

STEP 1

Shape a pinky-sized piece of clay into a flat oval shape. Turning the egg on it's side, affix the oval to the egg. This will represent Milli's helmet!

STEP 2

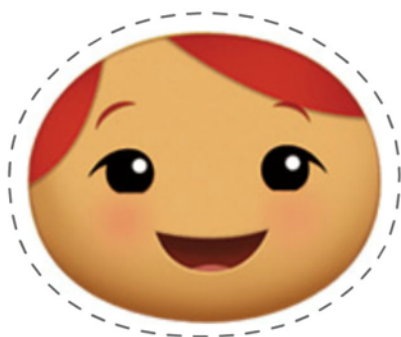
Roll two additional fingertip-sized pieces of clay into balls and affix to the top of Milli's head, using the photo for reference. Place a pipe cleaner in each ball to make Milli's antennae. Make sure you bend them down at the middle!

STEP 3

Print and cut the Milli templates. Place the face atop the helmet piece of clay and press down. Glue the flowers around the egg and on the pink paper rectangle, using the photo for reference.

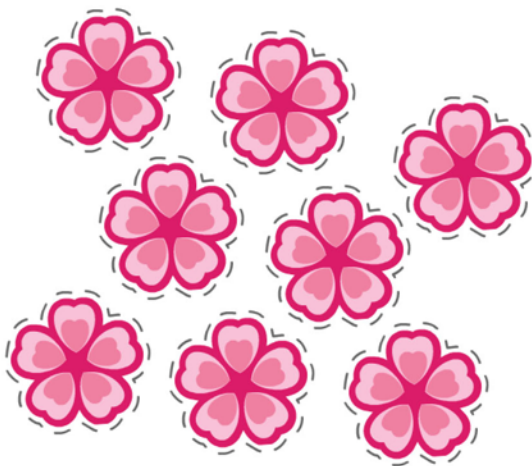
STEP 4

Curl the pink rectangle into a ring and glue or staple it closed. Once dry (~½ hour), rest Milli's head atop her flowered ring!
