



RED RANGER ORNAMENT



SAFETY REMINDER

Only a grown-up should cut out the Ranger parts and use the cutting knife.

MATERIALS

- 8 1/2" X 11" cardstock
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Cutting knife
- Glue
- Hole punch
- String



DIRECTIONS

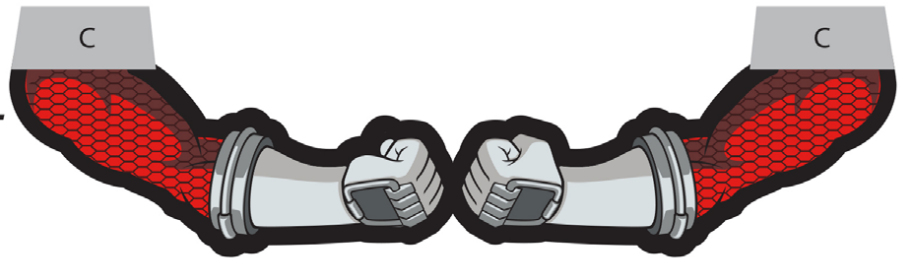
1. Print the following page on cardstock and cut out the parts.
2. Using a ruler, score along the dashed lines to ensure lines are straight.
3. Use a cutting knife to cut through the white dotted lines on the Body. The arms will go through these later.
4. On the Head, glue the backside of Tab A to the backside of Tab B.
5. Glue Tab A on the Head to the underside of 1 on the Body.
6. Cut out each arm as one piece and fold in half. Glue the back sides of each arm together.
7. Attach the Arms to the Body, with the Right Arm through the right-side body slit and the Left Arm through the left-side body slit. Glue Tab C on the Right Arm to the underside of the right-side body slit, and glue Tab D on the Left Arm to the underside of the left-side body slit.
8. Enclose the Body by gluing Tab E on the Body to Tab B on the Head.
9. Complete the Power Ranger's Body by gluing Tab F to the underside of 2.
10. Punch a hole through the black dot in the gray tab on the top of the Ranger's Head, and loop a string through the hole then knot it.
11. Hang the ornament on your tree.



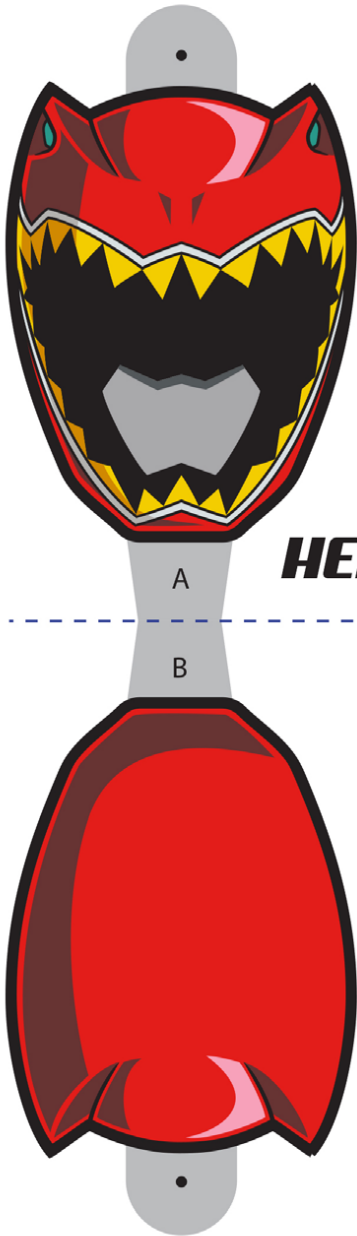
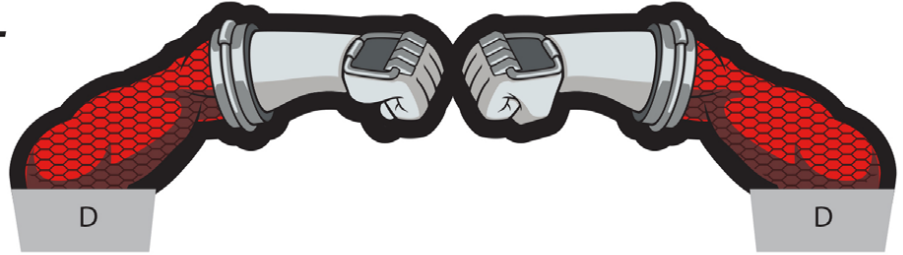

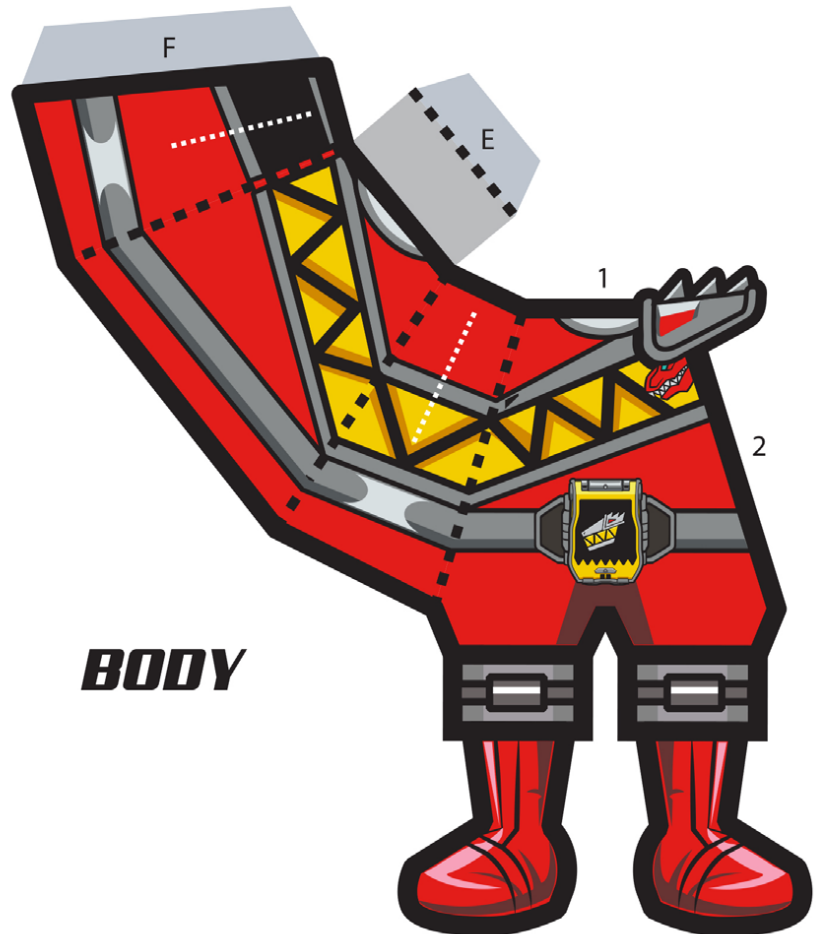

BLACK RANGER ORNAMENT

DIRECTIONS

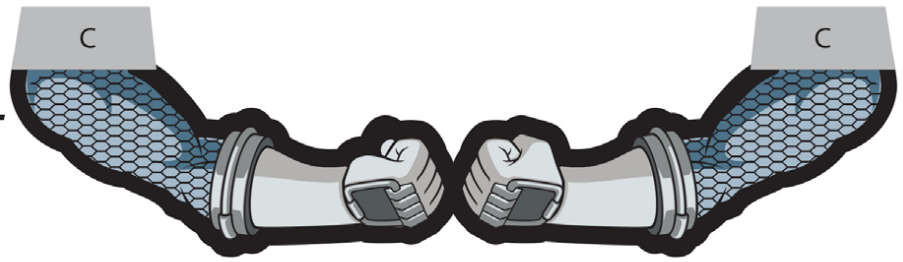
1. Print the following page on cardstock and cut out the parts.
2. Using a ruler, score along the dashed lines to ensure lines are straight.
3. Use a cutting knife to cut through the white dotted lines on the Body. The arms will go through these later.
4. On the Head, glue the backside of Tab A to the backside of Tab B.
5. Glue Tab A on the Head to the underside of 1 on the Body.
6. Cut out each arm as one piece and fold in half. Glue the back sides of each arm together.
7. Attach the Arms to the Body, with the Right Arm through the right-side body slit and the Left Arm through the left-side body slit. Glue Tab C on the Right Arm to the underside of the right-side body slit, and glue Tab D on the Left Arm to the underside of the left-side body slit.
8. Enclose the Body by gluing Tab E on the Body to Tab B on the Head.
9. Complete the Power Ranger's Body by gluing Tab F to the underside of 2.
10. Punch a hole through the black dot in the gray tab on the top of the Ranger's Head, and loop a string through the hole then knot it.
11. Hang the ornament on your tree.



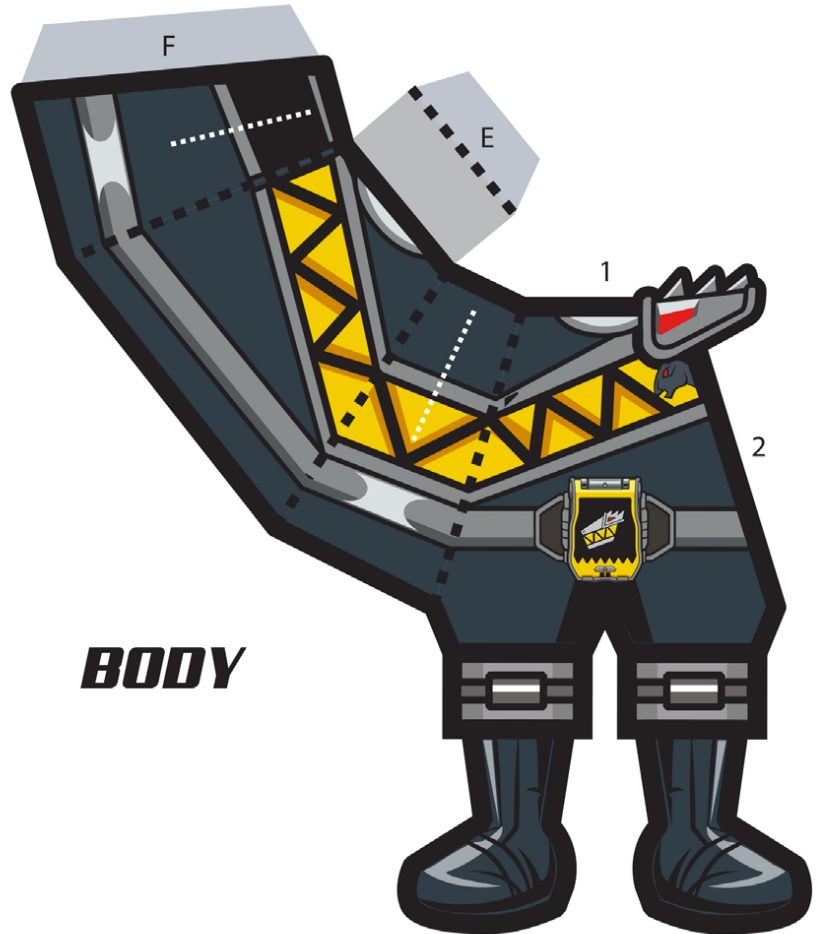
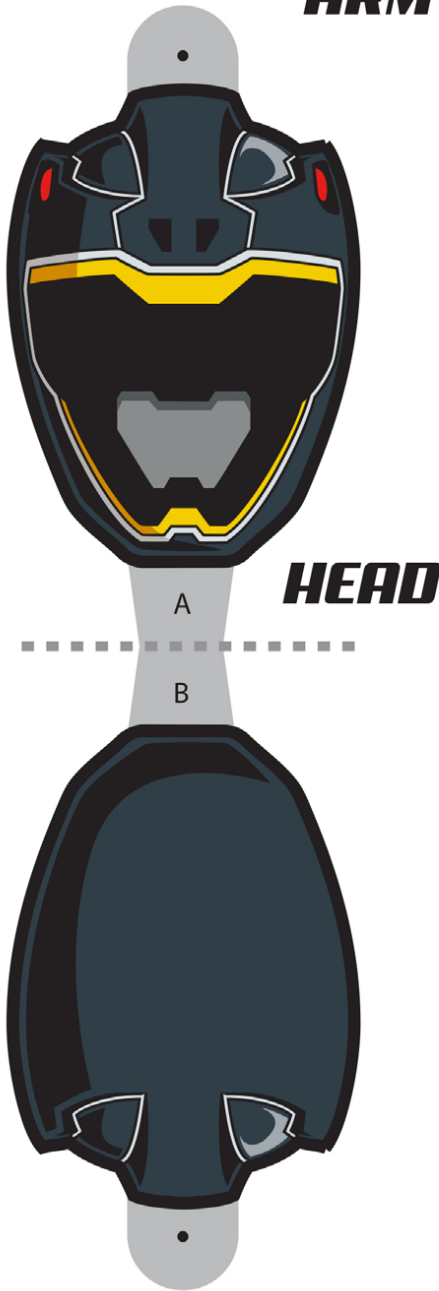
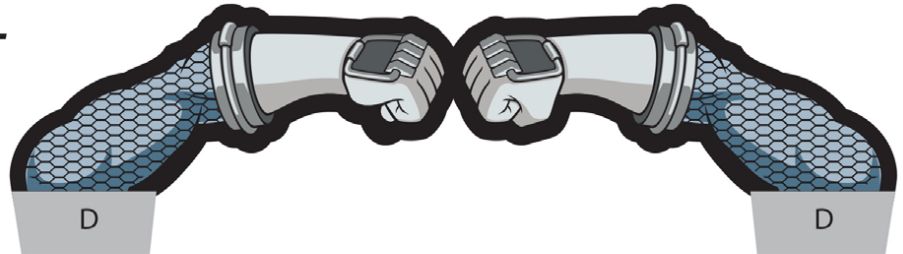

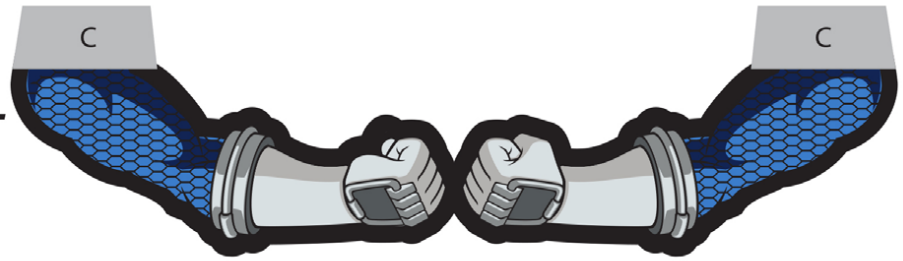
1. Print the following page on cardstock and cut out the parts.

8. Enclose the Body by gluing Tab E on the Body to Tab B on the Head.
9. Complete the Power Ranger's Body by gluing Tab F to the underside of 2.
10. Punch a hole through the black dot in the gray tab on the top of the Ranger's Head, and loop a string through the hole then knot it.
11. Hang the ornament on your tree.



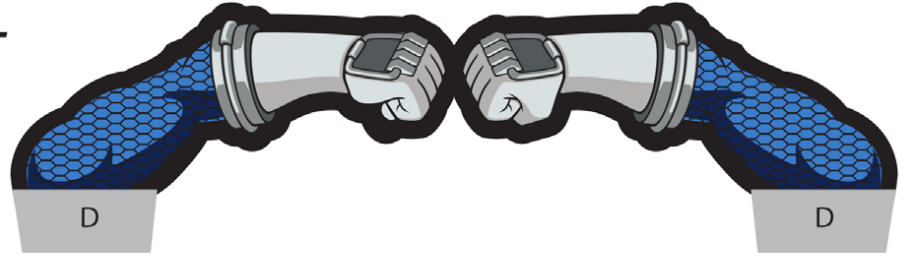

BLUE RANGER ORNAMENT

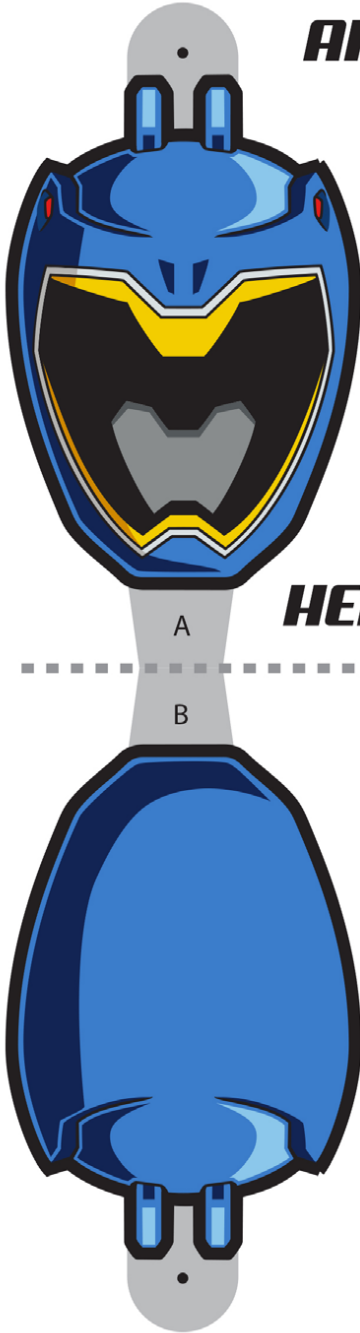

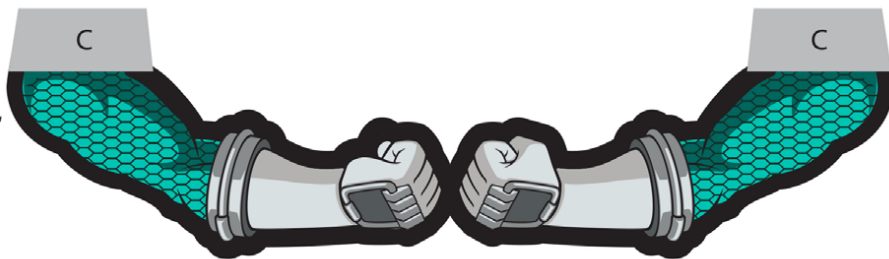

GREEN RANGER ORNAMENT

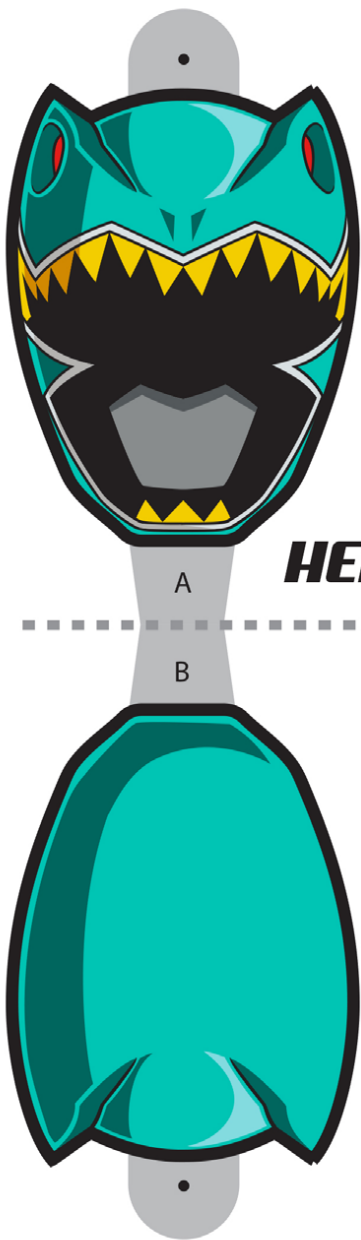

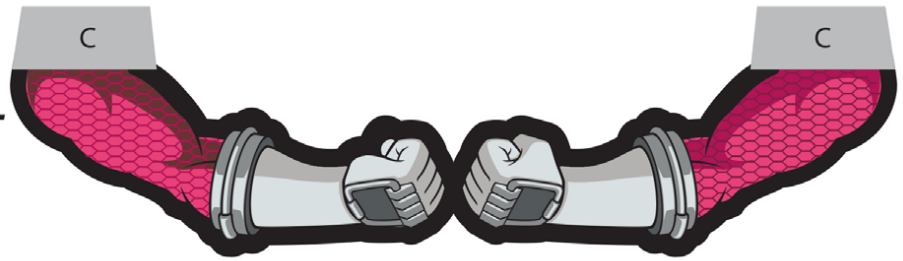

PINK RANGER ORNAMENT

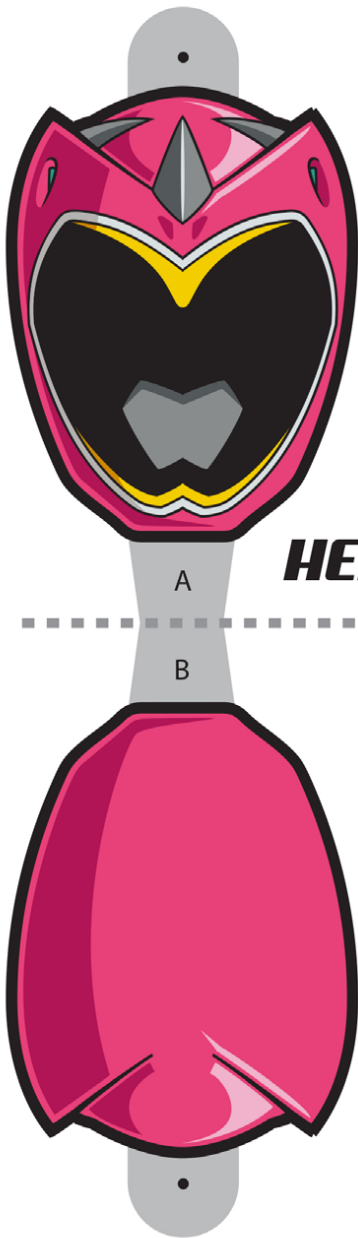

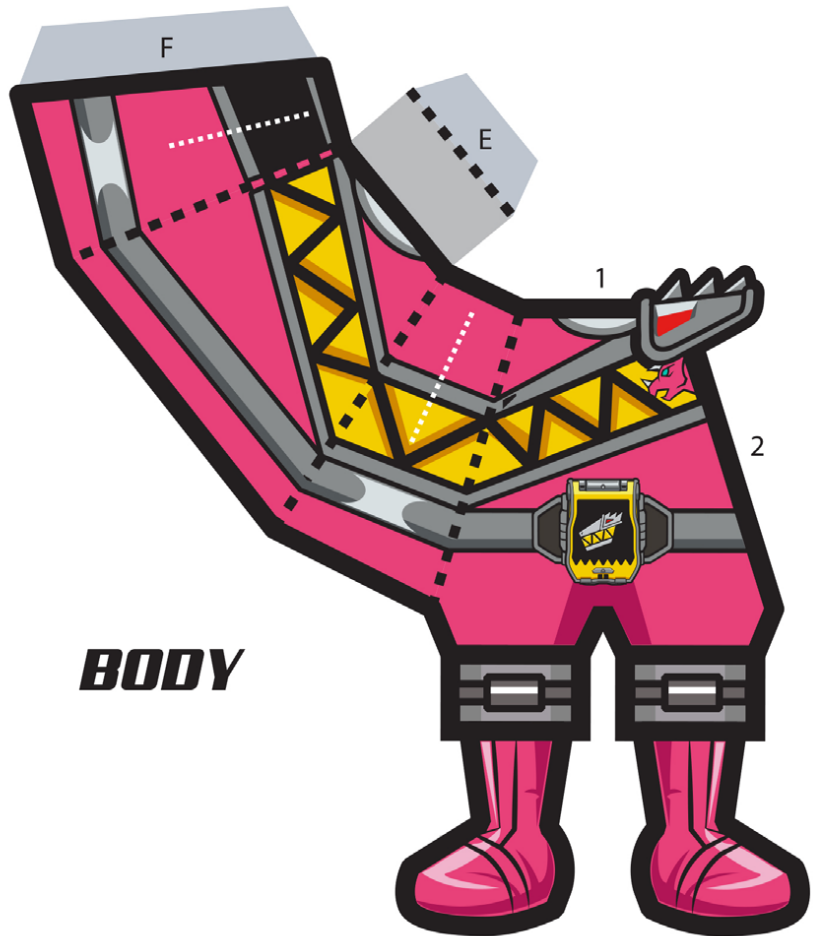
